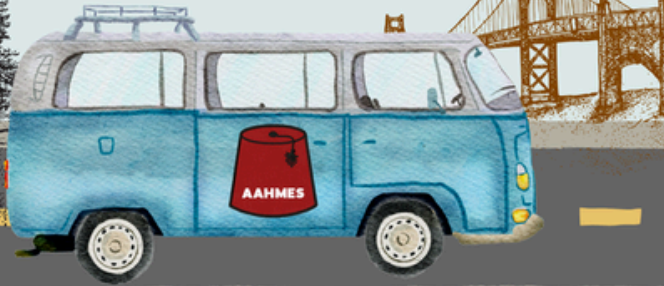

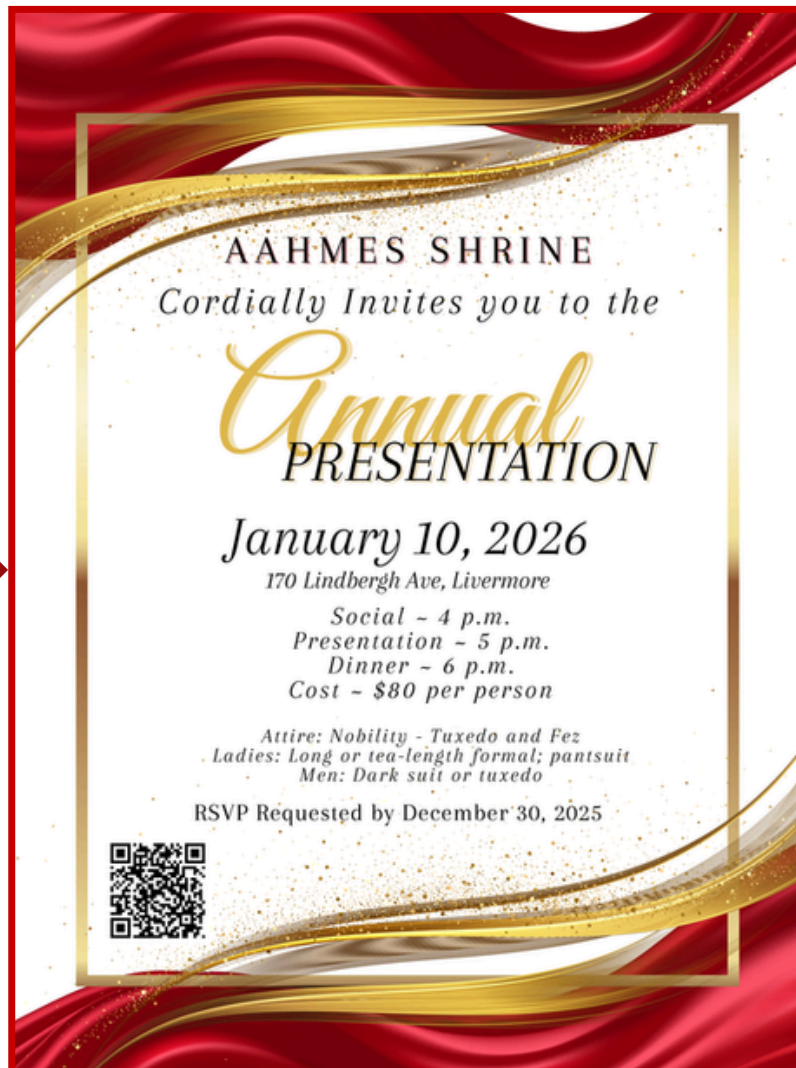

## Aahmes Shrine Clubs Join Forces

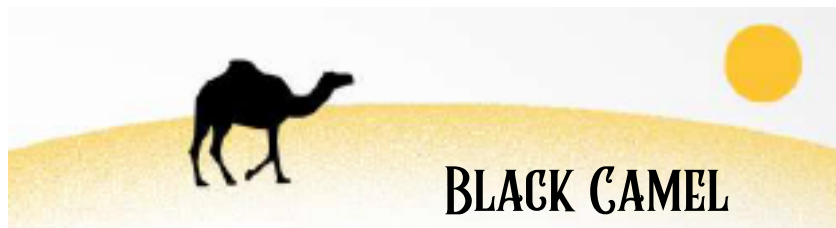

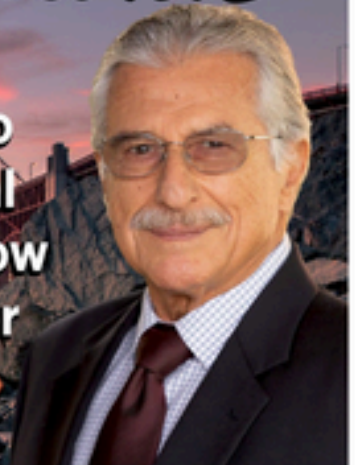
